

CLEAN, RELIABLE ENERGY

Skyline will produce domestic, affordable, environmentally friendly energy to the Keezletown community. The project will offset approximately 108,000 tons of CO₂, which is equivalent to emissions produced by 21,000 homes for one year.

ONGOING REVENUE

The project is expected to generate approximately \$8.8 million in tax revenue over the anticipated lifetime of 35 years. This money can be used to benefit numerous county services with no strain on public infrastructure.

RESPONSIBLE NEIGHBOR

Unlike many other types of development, solar projects are quiet and responsible neighbors that generate no **pollution, noise, odor, or traffic after construction**. The project will be screened from roads and houses with trees, shrubs, and topography.

JOBS

Skyline Solar will create approximately 240 well-paying construction jobs during construction and provide a boost to local hospitality businesses.
